TOURNAMENTS – Susan Pennington

There will be lots of opportunities to play golf over the next few weeks. As a reminder to our returning members and as an explanation to our new members, this will be a brief review of how to play in our weekly events.

Each Tuesday we have reserved tee times with the pro shop. On Tuesday you can make up your own foursome and sign up as a group or you can go on the app and sign up individually wherever there is an opening. The tee time and group you sign up for will be your time and foursome on Tuesday.

On Thursday, you also sign up on the app under the WGA tab any place there is an opening. Thursdays are sweeps days with either a team or individual game. On Wednesday the pro shop will arrange the players and the tee times and they will send out an email to all players that are signed up providing details. If you do not receive the email, check the tee times on the app for that day under the WGA tab.

The games for the next few weeks are as follows:

1/20/22: **Three-Two-One**: This is a foursome event requiring 3 best balls on par 3's, 2 best balls on par 2's and 1 best ball on par 5's.

2/3/22: **Bridgeman**: This is a foursome event. The 18 holes are divided into three 6-hole segments. Use one best ball on holes 1 thru 6, two best balls on holes 7 thru 12 and three best balls on holes 13 thru 18.

We also have special events coming up within the next month in addition to our regular Tuesday and Thursday events.

1/13/22: January Guest Day, this is CLOSED as of the time of writing

1/27/22 and 2/1/22: Round one and two of our **Member-Member tournament**. A sign-up sheet is in the ladies locker room and the deadline to sign up is 1/23/22. This is a 2-day tournament and you choose your own partner. Be sure you can each play on both days. Handicaps are capped at 36 and there is a maximum 10 stroke differential between partners. The format is a two-day eclectic. It is a net only tournament and all participants must use a golf cart for pace of play.

2/6/22: **Couples Tournament with MGA** including dinner. You will not be paired with your spouse/partner/significant other. The 2-person team will be arranged for you. It will be a shamble format with flights. Check in the pro shop to sign up and to pay the fee which, as of this writing, has not been finalized.

Please remember to bring a few dollars with you when you attend our monthly luncheons and meetings on the first Thursday of each month. We hold a **50/50 drawing** at each monthly meeting. Last week we awarded \$55 to two lucky winners and the other half went into the WGA's funds to supplement our sweeps payouts. It is a win-win for all of us and we appreciate your participation.

Most of these topics will be covered once you have signed up. However, there are a few conditions of joining that need to be met and these are listed below!


- 1. You will need to have a **36 or less handicap** on April 1. Prior Members are grandfathered in regardless of handicap.
- 2. Participants are required to **pay a fee of \$20** which is used to sponsor a sign for the Fallies, to provide tips to our staff when we host here at Desert Falls, as well as miscellaneous expenses.
- 3. You are also required to **purchase a team shirt** from the pro shop which we typically use for 2 seasons. We are currently working on the shirt selection.
- 4. The season begins on **April 7th and we will play every Monday and Thursday thru May 9**. Please respond to Nancy or Eva regarding your availability to play these matches April thru May.
- 5. Once the roster is complete, Nancy will send each of you a **form to indicate your match availability.** The match schedule will be completed and your will be notified of your play dates and locations. Typically, depending on your availability, you can expect to play 3-4 matches.

We are very excited to be playing spring team again and are looking forward to the season. The main goal of Spring Net Team is to have fun! Playing many of the wonderful courses in the valley to which we normally would not have access is a real bonus gained from participating in Spring Team. RULES, PAM FRIEDMAN





Temporary Local Rule: Preferred Lies or "Lift, Clean and Place"

If a player's ball lies on a closely-mown area through the green the player may mark, lift and clean the ball without penalty. Before lifting, she must mark the position of the ball. The player must then place the ball on a spot within one club length of and not nearer the hole than where it originally lay, that is not in a penalty area or on the putting green.

Notes:

This rule only applies to "closely mown areas" – those parts of the course cut to fairway height or less. This means the **fairway** of the hole you are playing and the fringes or aprons around the greens.

You MUST mark the position of the ball before lifting, cleaning and placing — failure to do so leads to a one-stroke penalty.

May a player spin or rotate the ball on the green to line it up to the hole without marking the ball.

No, the 1st paragraph of Rule 14.1 makes clear that rotating the ball is the same as lifting it. So, if the player fails to mark the spot before doing so, she/he incurs a one-stroke penalty.


